- All abstract submitters must complete a <u>copyright transfer agreement form (PDF file</u>). Please read instructions under Abstract Submission on the <u>Instructions</u> page.
- If you submitted your abstract by the first deadline (Apr 17) and you are paying the registration fee by check or money order, you **must submit your payment by May 12**, 2000 in order for your abstract to be published in the journal.
- All abstract submitters are invited to submit a four-page manuscript to be published in the Symposium Proceedings Volume. Deadline for draft: June 29. Please see the <u>manuscript</u> instructions page.
- The *first* deadline for abstract submission has passed. We extended the final deadline for abstract submission to June 21. If you submitted your abstract before the first deadline of April 17, your abstract will be published in a special issue of the journal "Luminescence". Abstracts submitted between April 17 and June 21 will not appear in the journal, "Luminescence", but will be provided in a packet at the Symposium.
